

Centenary Lounge

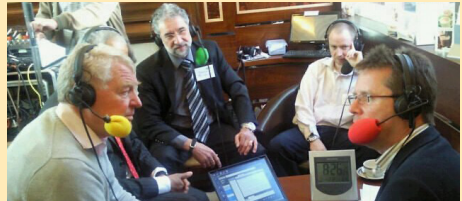
